<p><b>What is one nutritional benefit of eating buffalo meat?</b></p> <p>Answers may include low in fat and calories, high in vitamins and minerals, and adds variety to the diet.</p>	<p><b>What are two ways to cook buffalo?</b></p> <p>Answers may include grilling, baking, broiling, and stir-frying.</p>	<p><b>On the average, how much does a Plains buffalo weigh?</b></p> <p>Approximately 2000 pounds</p>	<p><b>What was one use of the buffalo's tail?</b></p> <p>Answers may include fly brush, whips, knife switch, and decorations.</p>
