Shelter Details

- 9 picnic tables (one ADA-accessible table); seating for 75-90 people, depending on age
- Additional folding tables available by request
- Multiple electric outlets
- Projection screen and system available by request

Usage Guidelines

To help accommodate various shelter users on busy field trip days:

- From 11:00-1:00, groups eating lunch have priority over those using the shelter as a workspace.
- Keep the shelter clean and avoid leaving your materials or equipment in the shelter in a way that disrupts other users.
- The shelter is a shared resource. Be considerate of and make room for others.
- Field trip garbage, including lunch waste, should return with you on the bus or go in the central dumpster by the restrooms. Please reserve the shelter garbage cans for other users.

Teacher/Educator Reservations

- WCC Staff will have priority for shelter use. We will not take teacher shelter reservations unless we are confident it will not conflict with WCC-led programming.
- Any reservations we can accommodate will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. Day-of use is also on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- In most cases, there is no charge for school-based shelter use.
