



# Tree Bingo

Mark an X in each square that you find. The back of this sheet has some tips and hints. You can use leaves growing on a tree or leaves you find on the ground.

Alternate branching	Moss growing on a tree	A leaf with lobes along the edges	Signs of an insect on a tree	A simple leaf
A vine growing up a tree	A tree with rough bark	A bird looking for food in a tree	Seeds from a tree	A leaf with at least 2 colors
Rough and smooth bark on the same tree	A leaf with teeth along the edges	An evergreen (coniferous) tree	A tree with buds on it	Opposite branching
A compound leaf	A tree that's shorter than you	A deciduous tree	A baby tree just starting to grow	A cone from an evergreen tree
An animal home in a tree	A tree still waiting for its leaves to come	A tree with smooth bark	A leaf with smooth edges	A tree that's taller than you



Leaves branch out from twigs and branches either oppositely or alternately. Whether a leaf pattern is alternate or opposite can help you identify the tree itself. If the branch doesn't have any leaves, look for the buds that will eventually turn into leaves.




Simple leaves have a single leaf blade. Compound leaves have multiple leaf blades or leaflets.

Always check where the leaf attaches the larger branch, not where leaflets might attach to each other.



A coniferous tree keeps its leaves (needles) over the winter.



A deciduous tree loses its leaves in the fall.

A squirrel chattering	A dead leaf	A flower with an insect on it	A bird singing	An ant moving something
Tree bark	A bird flying	An animal eating	Something splashing or swimming in water	A bird with at least 2 colors on it
A bug crawling on something	A frog or toad calling or jumping	Something sticky	At least 3 flowers of different colors	Something smooth
