No Prep

- Play on the playground in the campground



Minimal Prep

- Create your own nature scavenger hunt or use [one of ours](#)
- Hunt for geocaches around the lake with [geocaching.com](#)
- Play games on the campground ballfield like baseball, kickball, or volleyball

Most Prep

 - Use our kayak launch on the West side of the lake
- Catch and release fishing
 - Bring your own supplies and bait
